2024 COMMUNITY PARADE REGISTRATION

THEME: "BUILDING OUR FUTURE TOGETHER" SEPTEMBER 21, 2024- 9:30 A.M. RAIN OR SHINE

Distribution of candy, literature, brand items: Only individuals walking along the curb will be permitted to distribute candy, distribute gifts and/or literature. NO ITEMS ARE TO BE THROWN INTO THE CROWD. It is recommended that at least four people walk with their entry to distribute the candy, literature or other branded items. The people that are distributing must keep up with their entry. Any printed material is to be handed to the spectators, and not forced on them

Horse Units: All horse units or horse drawn units must have provisions to remove any animal excrement immediately from the street. Any unit that has not made these provisions is subject to being rejected from participating in the parade. The parade committee will not make any provisions for the service of removal.

Pets: No pets of any kind will be permitted to walk in the parade without advanced written permission of the parade committee. A request must be submitted in writing prior to the registration deadline. Unit must have provisions to remove any animal excrement immediately from street. Any unit that has not made these provisions is subject to being rejected from participating in the parade. All pets must be leashed.

Unit Breakdowns: Any unit that breaks down must pull out of the parade line-up. If repairs can be made they may reenter the line-up with direction of the parade officials.

Remain in or on vehicle: Do not jump from or get out of any moving vehicle or float. Limbs must be INSIDE float or vehicle at all times. Failure to abide by this rule may be cause for removal from parade line-up.

Additional Safety Requirement: All entries with floats or walkers must have someone to monitor for safety. You are responsible to insure the safety of all persons participating with your entry.

Keep entry moving: Do not stop your vehicle unless the parade stops or you are instructed to do so by a parade official or public safety officer.

Youth Entries: All youth entries should ride in a vehicle. If they are a walking unit or too large of a group for a vehicle, then they are to have a pace vehicle and the unit is to keep up with the pace vehicle.

Emergency Vehicles: If an emergency does occur, then pull to the right side of the street to allow them to pass. Remain to the right side of the street until the parade resumes or you are instructed to do so by the parade officials or public safety officer.

Each entry will be issued an Entry ID Number which must be prominently displayed on the front of the entry; i.e., floats pulled by a motor vehicle must display the number in the front window of the motor vehicle, etc.

I have read the rules of the parade and agree to abide by those rules and further agree to abide by the directives from parade officials on the day of the parade. I further understand that if my entry violates these rules I can be removed from the parade and not be permitted to participate in future parades in Grove City. The Grove City Area Chamber reserves the right to change rules and policies as they see fit. As a parade entry, I have liability insurance and further assume all liability for my participation in the parade, holding the City of Grove City, The Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce, the Grove City Girls' Club, and any sponsors of the parade harmless. Decisions of the Parade Committee are final.
